#### **Campus Update**

Yesterday, we communicated that a staff member in our Health Care Center tested positive for COVID-19 and that the Wauwatosa Department of Health asked us to test all residents and staff working on the affected unit. As a result, we tested all residents yesterday using the test kits we had. Today, we received test results for all 39 residents on the unit. Of the group, two came back positive. These two residents have already been moved to our observation unit that is equipped to care for COVID-19 positive patients. All staff who interacted with these two residents and the families of these residents have also been notified. The two residents are both doing well and are not showing signs of the infection. We will continue monitoring them for any changes.

Late this afternoon, we received additional test kits and began testing staff who work on the affected unit. You know that since mid-March, all staff have been wearing masks and are being screened for symptoms and fever so precautions have been in place to mitigate the spread if someone was to become ill. These precautions were taken to help protect both residents and staff. We will keep you updated as this progresses and how this testing may affect residents in our assisted living and independent living programs.
