Campus Update

• You may have read that the Washington/Ozaukee County Department of Health ended their lockdown order that was put in place during a time of significant COVID spread in the area. This order had implemented additional restrictions on

senior living facilities in their counties, including restricting staff from working at more than one facility to reduce the spread of COVID from facility to facility. The Department ended the order because the extreme precautions were no longer deemed necessary given the slowing of cases in the counties and in light of the myriad rules in place by the CDC, CMS and Wisconsin Department of Health. We continue to follow those guidelines and will keep in place our own policy to restrict staff from working at other facilities.

Campus Happenings

- Over the weekend, we tested all residents in our Courtyards program after learning that a resident in the hospital tested positive for COVID. The results determined that two residents were positive. They have been moved to our COVID unit in the Health Care Center for continued care. We also began to test staff again in this program area. This testing continued today and will conclude on Tuesday. We expect results to begin coming back as soon as Tuesday. As always, we are working with the Wauwatosa Department of Health on appropriate next steps. We will keep you updated throughout the week.
