Campus Updates



On Monday we shared that a Courtyard resident tested positive for COVID-19. Results for all the remaining Courtyard residents are back and the good news is all test results came back negative. We completed about 90% of the staff tests on Tuesday and expect to complete the rest as soon as possible. The resident who tested positive continues to receive care in our health care center observation unit that is designed for COVID patients. Our heightened precautions and ongoing monitoring help to mitigate the spread when someone does become ill. We will keep you updated as the staff test results are returned.
