If you received our update on March 21st you recall we had one of residents from the Health Care Center who was in the hospital, tested positive for COVID-19. She is doing well at the hospital and we ask for your continued prayers for her, all of our residents, the family they are missing and our staff. At this time, there are no positive cases of COVID-19 on the Luther Manor campus, this includes residents and staff. This remains our highest priority!

There are no significant updates since last night, so here's a general update:

- Something we have not brought up before is supplies. We are monitoring them daily, we secured them (especially the toilet paper) and have forecasted the duration of those that we have in stock. Although many areas around the country have seen shortages, we have partnered well with our trusted vendors, the Department of Health and others and we plan to keep it that way.
- Most of you know our website has the link to send loved ones and staff members letters from home, photos or words of encouragement. We are getting so many of these, as well as cards and handmade pictures from the community that we cannot say thank you enough. It is absolutely helping to keep everyone's spirits up!
