# **Campus Update**

- Information continues to come from the Wisconsin Department of Health regarding the increased availability of Covid-19 testing for **nursing home** residents and staff. We expect to work with the Wauwatosa Department of Health over the next several days to better understand our options and to establish a game plan for Luther Manor.
- Speaking of the Wisconsin Department of Health, today they began disclosing the names of **Nursing Home** facilities that have an active public health investigation of Covid-19. Facilities will be removed from the list 28 days after the last positive case was confirmed.
