

Luther Manor Continuing Precautions Related to COVID-19

Good evening from Luther Manor. Although there are still no newly acquired resident cases of COVID-19 at Luther Manor, we do have an update regarding one of our employees. This afternoon we were notified that a limited part-time employee of Luther Manor's Health Care Center tested positive for COVID-19. After reviewing our schedules and working with the City of Wauwatosa's Department of Health, we confirmed that this individual **was NOT on campus** during the timeframe of concern. With this said, we will continue with our stringent protocols, precautions and twice daily screening of staff and three times daily vitals checks for all Health Care Center and Assisted Living Residents. In addition, all staff continue to wear masks on campus and are adhering to proper hygiene and infection control protocols. Working closely with the Department of Health, we will monitor the situation closely and will contact any resident, family member or staff directly if necessary.

This situation highlights that because this pandemic has not concluded, we **all must remain constant** in adhering to the necessary precautions. Our number one priority continues to be the health and safety of our residents and staff. Thank you for your care and commitment to our residents and staff during this extremely challenging time. We know that your calls and notes make a difference in keeping spirits up!

- With many of our residents not possessing a phone or the ability to easily handle a device when making a call, we have many of our employees volunteering to come in next Saturday and Sunday to help our residents' families connect with their mothers. We have time slots available for about 100 phone calls, Facetime or Zoom multi-person 10-minute calls this coming Saturday or Sunday.  - Your phone number we can call with questions
 - Your first and second preferred time on Saturday or Sunday
 - We have openings as follows:
 - Saturday from 8 am 1 pm
 - Sunday from 9 am 3 pm

If your mother has a phone and can manage it on her own, we ask that you not take advantage of this service. This way we can save our volunteers for those that cannot do this on their own. Thank you for your understanding!

Reminder, we will be sending updates on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays until further notice. If something pressing comes up we will certainly be communicating on the other days, including weekends as necessary.
