Luther Manor Continuing Precautions Related to COVID-19

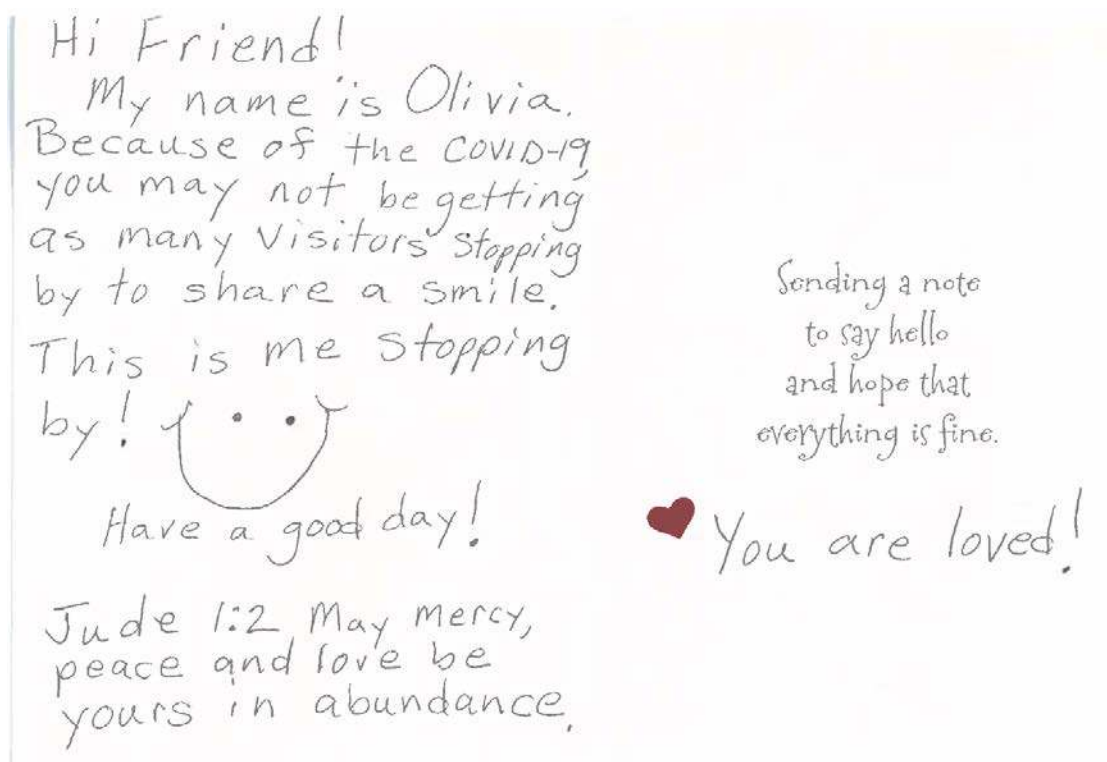

our residents who have been tested for working with us to help keep everyone safe. If you've been tested yourself, you know it isn't a very pleasant or comfortable experience.

Campus Update

- All testing of residents and staff in the Courtyards is complete with the exception of one staff member. In addition to the first resident case we communicated on Wednesday, one additional resident tested positive among all 73 of our residents in that area. Results from the staff tests should be back early next week. We have conducted vitals checks on all Health Care Center and Assisted Living residents three times per day and all staff twice per day since mid-March. We are also monitoring residents for symptoms to help us identify any changes in their condition. Wearing our masks and following proper hand hygiene helps prevent COVID from coming into the building. Having the protocols in place to identify cases early through screening and monitoring along with the cleaning, disinfecting and careful PPE precautions helps to control the spread when cases do occur. We will continue to keep you updated.

- At our River Oaks location in Mequon, resident Edith went back to her gardening roots and helped plant our patio pots. When she was offered gloves for the task by Kenny, our program manager, she exclaimed, "I don't do garden gloves! Let me show you how it's done!" You tell him Edith!
