Campus Updates

- Here's a reminder that our Independent Living residents in the Terrace return to our reopening phases as of August 4th. The same requirements exist as before we had to pause the reopening. If you can assist your loved ones and follow the following rules yourselves, we would really appreciate it.
 - Independent Living Residents in the Terrace will be able to restart outdoor visits. These visits are limited to 2 visitors and yes are outside only.
 Please practice social distancing and masks are required to be worn by all for the visit.
 - Exercise rooms will open up by appointment only. Reservations need to be made by calling Stephanie Rutkowski in Life Enrichment or Katie and Linda in the Terrace offices. Residents need to check in at one of the Terrace offices as well.
 - The Beauty Shop and Massage therapy appointments are to be scheduled in advance with the respective providers of service.
 - Residents will no longer need to self-isolate after leaving the campus, except after a hospital visit (note Dr. Office visits will no longer require the 14-day self-isolation).
