Campus Updates

- Through our routine testing we learned that two staff members in our Health Care Center are positive for COVID-19. All staff and the families of those having loved ones who may have had direct contact with these individuals have been notified. If you were not contacted by us, your loved one is not affected. We tested all residents in this area and will continue to test all staff twice per week until directed to change this by the Department of Health. Because of the positive cases, this area is now under quarantine for at least the next 14 days. Once again if you were not contacted your loved one's area is not under quarantine. For early detection purposes, we continue to monitor residents for symptoms to help identify changes in condition and we also screen all staff members each day including checking temperatures twice on every shift. Together with wearing masks and following frequent cleaning, hand hygiene and social distancing protocols, we have precautions in place to help mitigate the spread when someone becomes ill.

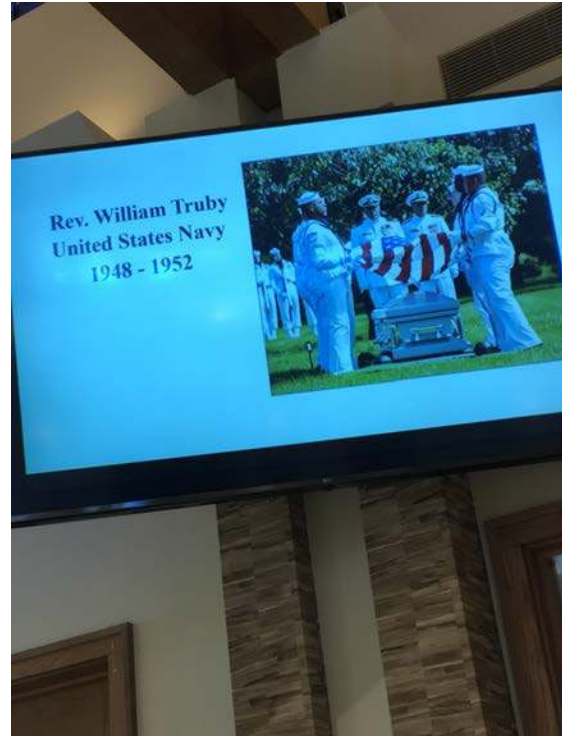
Campus Happenings
