## **Campus Update**

• Following up on last week's communication when we informed you about a Health Care Center staff member that tested positive for COVID-19, our highest priority continues to be the well-being of our residents and staff. Our routine biweekly testing found that another, unrelated member of that team is positive, so we will test again all residents on the unit who may have been exposed. At this time, none of these residents are experiencing signs or symptoms of COVID. We are working closely with the Wauwatosa Department of Health to ensure all residents and staff who came in direct contact with the staff member are notified and monitoring symptoms. The unit affected is under quarantine per Department of Health guidelines until we are sure no new cases arise from this latest staff case.

All employees are screened as they arrive and leave work each day. If any symptoms are present, the employee is tested immediately and sent home with further instructions. All staff are already being proactively tested on a bi-weekly basis and all residents in the health care center and assisted living are screened for symptoms three times a day. Our heightened precautions and ongoing



monitoring help with early detection and to mitigate the spread when someone does become ill. Our top priority continues to be stopping this virus and doing our best to keep COVID-19 from spreading. We will continue to do our best to connect personally with each resident and strive to enrich the mind, body and soul of our residents.
