#### **Campus Update**

 On Monday our Courtyards program was released from their quarantine and residents are now able to move about the building. As part of our reopening plan, in-person visits can now begin taking place again. Families of Courtyards residents should contact our Life Enrichment Coordinator, Shari Garza, to schedule a visit. We continue to prepare for when the Health Care Center units come out of quarantine and visits can resume.

Our routine bi-weekly testing in the Health Care Center found a member of that team tested positive. We tested all residents on the unit who may have been exposed and will do so again in 5 days. At this time, none of these residents are experiencing signs or symptoms of COVID. All families have been notified so if you haven't heard from us your loved one was not affected. We continue to work closely with the Wauwatosa Department of Health to ensure aprecautions are being followed to help mitigate the spread. The unit affected is under quarantine until we are sure no new cases arise from this latest staff case.
