

Luther Manor Continuing Precautions Related to COVID-19



Campus Updates

• Our Health Care Center bi-weekly staff testing continues into next week at least. The Department of Health Guidelines state will then look at the positivity rate and only adjust the frequency if the County rate goes below 10%. The Courtyard testing will continue to be directed by the Department of Health this week. We will continue to keep you updated.



The results from our COVID testing in the Health Care Center and Courtyard continue to come in on a daily basis (usually within two business days of administering the test). All of the Courtyard residents tests this week have come back negative. There are two more staff members in the Health Care Center as well as in one in the Courtyards that tested positive. These employees have minimal interaction with our non-COVID positive residents, yet per our standard protocol we have conducted contact tracing and communicated with anyone they may have come in direct contact with. Our heightened precautions and ongoing monitoring help to mitigate the spread when someone does become ill or test positive.

Our top priority continues to be stopping this virus and doing our best to keep COVID-19 from spreading. We will continue to do our best to connect personally with each resident on a regular basis and strive to engage with them and help them through these difficult times, regardless of what phase of quarantine or reopening we are in.
