Campus Update

• This morning, we received confirmation from Walgreens that they will hold their first vaccine clinic here at Luther Manor the week of January 11. At this time, their plan is to be on site for two days that week. Day one will be for ALL staff and our Health Care Center residents with day two being dedicated for all other residents including those in our Terrace independent living, and Courtyards and River Oaks assisted living programs. The second dose of the vaccine will be administered in the same order sometime in mid-February. From what we have been told, the Walgreens vaccine for Senior Living Facilities in Wisconsin will be from Moderna, not Pfizer.

There will be a lot of planning and scheduling needed to make this happen. Thank you in advance to everyone involved in facilitating this important event and to all of you for your understanding and patience as we work through this. Like with everything related to the COVID-19 virus, a vaccination process of this magnitude is a first at Luther Manor. We are confident that, as has been the case during the entire pandemic, we will come together to make it happen, and do all we can to continue protecting our residents and staff from the virus.

- Our weekly routine testing in the Health Care Center found three residents in one unit that tested positive. We have transferred these residents to our COVID specialty unit in the Health Care Center and we began re-testing all residents and contact tracing is complete. Families of those having loved ones who may have had direct contact with these individuals have been notified. If you were not contacted by us, your loved one is not affected. We will continue the quarantine in this unit and continue to test staff as directed by the Department of Health.
- We have lifted the quarantine in the rehabilitation unit 1700-1823 after the required amount of time has passed. With the quarantine lifted, in-person visits for residents that live in this unit can resume.
