Campus Happenings

• The Wisconsin Department of Health Services just announced that residents age 65 and older can begin receiving the vaccine as of January 25th. Here is the article. https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/news/releases/011921.htm

We have not received confirmation from Walgreens on a date to vaccinate our Independent Living residents. Without that certainty and the national death toll from COVID nearing 400,000 we ask you to work with your loved one **to contact**



their personal, primary care doctor about getting the vaccine through their clinic. You can also help them monitor the availability of vaccines at local pharmacies such as Walgreens and CVS with the hope to get their vaccine as soon as possible. If for any reason they can get it from their doctor before we can get it to them through the Pharmacy Partner Program on our campus. please encourage them to do so. I know that means leaving the campus but if they follow appropriate mask wearing and hand hygiene protocols, it could be worth it. So please contact your loved one's Doctor's office.

Campus Update

- We just found out that one of our Courtyard, two Health Care Center and four Terrace Supportive Living residents tested positive for COVID-19. As a result, we transferred all of these residents to our COVID Specialty Unit in the Health Care Center. The Department of Health has asked us to remain in guarantine. We will be retesting all Courtyard, Health Care Center and Terrace Supportive Living residents again Thursday of this week. We will continue to work closely with the Wauwatosa Department of Health to ensure precautions are being followed to help mitigate the spread and remain flexible with any changes to their guidelines.
- Results of the routine twice weekly Health Care Center staff testing found that two Health Care Center employees tested positive for COVID-19. Results from our weekly Courtyard and Terrace staff testing also had two Terrace and one Courtyard staff member test positive. We continue working closely with the Wauwatosa Department of Health on steps to contain the spread and as always. will keep you informed.
