Campus Happenings

- Through our continued efforts to bring the COVID vaccine to ALL Luther Manor residents and staff as soon as possible, we are pleased to share that Walgreens will vaccinate our residents of the Courtyards, River Oaks and our Terrace Independent and Supportive Living residents. All vaccinations will occur on February 2nd, which is the same day our Health Care Center residents and staff will get their second vaccine. Those receiving their first vaccine on February 2nd will receive their second vaccine on March 2nd. We expect to serve several hundred people on February 2 during our vaccine clinics. Considerable effort is being taken to help make the process easy and to encourage as many people as possible to be vaccinated.

For some perspective, Luther Manor held our first vaccine clinic on January 5; just 2 weeks after the vaccine was even approved for use. We were among the very first long-term care organizations in the state to get the vaccine. On January 25, the vaccine was approved for assisted living and independent living residents. Our February 2 clinic was scheduled to coincide with the waiting period for the second dose. We are very excited that a mere 5 weeks after the Pharmacy Partnership Program began delivering the vaccine to seniors across the nation, we will bring it to ALL of our residents - well ahead of the 700,000 Wisconsinites age 65 and older.
