


Luther Manor Continuing Precautions Related to COVID-19 January 25, 2021 5:31 pm

- As a reminder Walgreens will be providing the first vaccination for our residents of the Courtyards, River Oaks and our Terrace Independent and Supportive Living residents. All vaccinations will occur on February 2nd, which is the same day our Health Care Center residents and staff will get their second vaccine. Those receiving their first vaccine on February 2nd will receive their second vaccine on March 2nd. All Terrace and Supportive Living residents will be vaccinated in the Terrace. All staff and residents except for those living in the Terrace will be vaccinated in the Faith and Education center. If you are helping your loved one fill out their forms, please be sure to complete as much as you can and return them to your respective Luther Manor Contact by January 27th.
