

Luther Manor Continuing Precautions Related to COVID-19



Campus Update

• Following up on our communication from late last week we did retest our Health Care Center residents and the testing results found five residents and one staff member from the Health Care Center that tested positive. As a result, we transferred these residents to our COVID Specialty Unit in the Health Care Center. We are retesting all Courtyard and Health Care Center residents today. Families of the residents who may have been impacted have been contacted. If you did not hear from us, your loved one is not on the affected unit. As you know, outside of this testing, all employees continue to be screened as they arrive and leave work each day. If any symptoms are present, the employee is tested immediately and sent home with further instructions. Residents in our Health Care Center and Assisted Living programs continue to be screened daily for symptoms and our Independent Living Residents are urged to self-screen (including checking their temperature) at least one time daily. These heightened precautions and ongoing monitoring help with early detection and to mitigate the spread when someone does become ill.
