The second vaccine (booster) will be administered on February 2nd, which is also when any staff who could not come today will get their first vaccination. We still have not received updated information about when our Assisted Living or Independent Living residents will be able to receive theirs. Campus Update

 Our regular routine staff testing in the Health Care Center returned a positive test. The staff member works in a unit that was not already in quarantine. Contact tracing is complete and families of those having loved ones who may have had direct contact with the individual have been notified. signs or symptoms of COVID; however, we will test residents and continue to test staff as directed by the Department of Health.
