Campus Update

- Our follow up resident testing in our Health Care Center has unfortunately returned with eight Health Care Center residents returned with positive tests. Seven are from the same unit and are being transported to our specialty COVID unit. The other resident is also being relocated, protocols and contact tracing are being scrutinized, especially in the unit with the additional residents. Families of those having loved ones who may have had direct contact with the individuals have been notified. If you were not contacted by us, your loved one is not affected. We will test residents again tomorrow and continue to test staff as directed by the Department of Health. We continue to work closely with the Wauwatosa Department of Health to ensure precautions are being followed to help mitigate the spread and remain flexible with any changes to their guidelines.
- We lift the quarantine in the rehabilitation observation unit 1809-1900 tomorrow after the required amount of time has passed. With the quarantine lifted, in-person visits for residents that live in this unit can resume.
