


Luther Manor Continuing Precautions Related to COVID-19 December 23, 2020 4:13 pm

Campus Update

Yesterday we received a change in plans from Walgreens that they will now do
their first vaccine clinic here at Luther Manor on January 5th for all staff and
Health Care Center Residents only. The second dose of the vaccines will be
administered for those same individuals sometime in early February. The clinical
team will be contacting all responsible parties with the authorization forms in
advance of January 5th.

Walgreens informed us that their first communication to us was incorrect and per the Department of Health; our Terrace independent living, and Courtyards and River Oaks assisted living programs will be held at a later date. We apologize for this change for our Assisted Living and Independent Living residents, yet if there is anything we have learned since COVID started it's that everything is very fluid, all the time. Unfortunately, they could not be more specific for us, other than at a later date. We know how important this is and will update everyone as soon as we hear!



- Our weekly routine testing in the Health Care Center found two new residents in one unit that tested positive. We have transferred these residents to our COVID specialty unit in the Health Care Center and will retest all residents again on Thursday and again next week Monday. Families of those having loved ones who may have had direct contact with these individuals have been notified. If you were not contacted by us, your loved one is not affected. We will continue the quarantine in this unit and continue to test staff as directed by the Department of Health.
- We have lifted the quarantine in the Health Care Center unit for apartments 2200 2500 in collaboration with the Department of Health. With the quarantine lifted, in-person visits for residents that live in this unit can resume.
