## **Campus Update**

- We have lifted the quarantine of our residents in the Supportive Living program and ended the voluntary isolation for all other Terrace residents. This means all apartments in our Health Care Center, Rehabilitation and the Terrace are out of quarantine. With the quarantine lifted, in-person visits for residents that live in these units can resume at the end of next week. - The county COVID positivity rate has dropped to 8.8%, which is great news for the area. Milwaukee County will need to remain below the 10% level for another two week cycle before we will reduce the ongoing staff testing to weekly. We will keep you updated on this.
