Campus Update

 As a reminder, our process and guidelines for indoor visits have not changed and were initially created with the recommendations we received from the Department of Health and the CDC.

These guidelines include visits during a designated and scheduled time and day to allow for proper social distancing, as well as cleaning and disinfecting by our staff for each area. The visitor must be masked and screen-in including having their temperature taken, they must follow the most direct route to the designated visiting location and we ask that they not engage with other staff or residents along their way. If a visitor is not feeling well or has any COVID-19 symptoms we ask that they not visit. We will routinely clean and disinfect the entrances, hallways and high touch surfaces areas based on this visit schedule. Visiting other parts of the campus is not allowed at this time nor are pet visits. Visitors are allowed to bring treats, personal items, gifts, etc. with them as they come in. If you are new to our visiting spaces they do include plexiglass dividers. Each program area has some unique information they will share with you as you schedule your visit.

We know these are a lot of rules and restrictions and we appreciate your cooperation, as we try our best to meet the ongoing needs of our residents and their families while keeping the entire campus safe.
