 We had our first in person worship service and this past Sunday and as you can imagine it was a very special service. We cannot believe it's been a year since we were able to gather together like this and are just so happy to connect with God in this way. The residents were happy, emotional and of course excited to do it again:)



As mentioned last week the Terrace residents may attend worship on the 1st and 3rd Sundays of the month. The Health Care Center residents will attend on the 2nd Sunday of the month and the Assisted Living Residents will be on the 4th and 5th Sunday of each month. We kindly ask that when residents wish to attend in person, they sign up with their respective Life Enrichment team members to attend one worship service per month, so others wishing to attend have a chance. We will keep a 'waiting list' of 2 residents for each service in case of last-minute cancellations. With resident small group participation going from 10 to 15 people, we will use this standard in the Faith & Education center as well.

All of our previous precautions remain in place and must be utilized to attend small group events/activities. These include residents wearing their mask, using hand sanitizer before and after the service, social distancing at all times and attending only if they have no COVID-19 symptoms.

For residents not able to attend worship or mass in person, we are finalizing the process and guidelines for providing communion for our residents, in a safe manner.

 We will update Terrace residents and their families on changes to our visitor policy on Wednesday. We really appreciate everyone's patience on this. It may seem easy to just flip the switch, but many details and precautions need to be worked out and then executed upon.
