### HOW DID WE PROTECT?

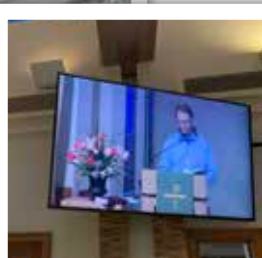
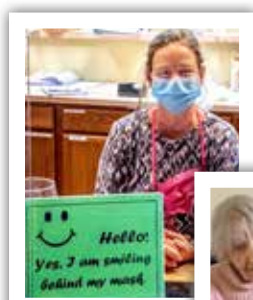

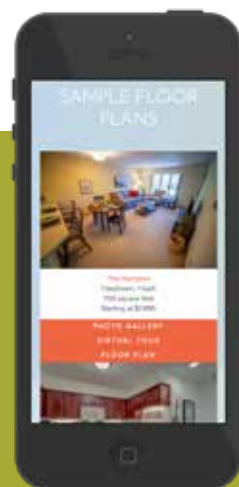
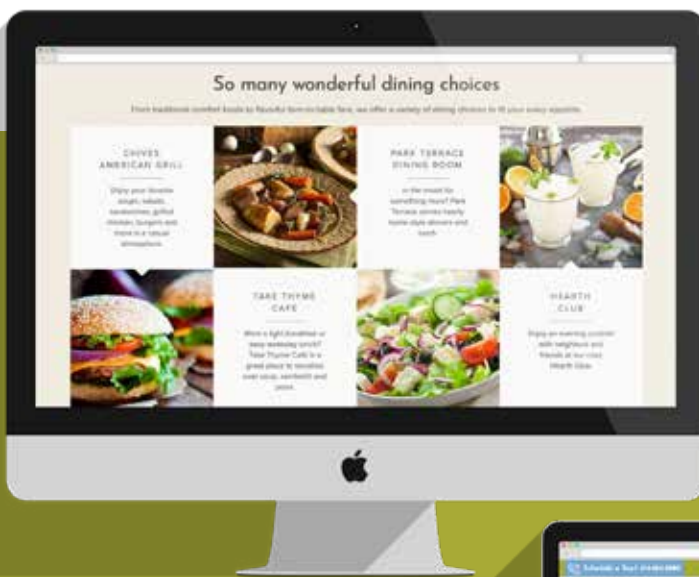


# UPDATES UPGRADES & *Uplifts*

## OUR 2020 SOAR SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS

**Luther Manor is helping to make college more affordable for two volunteers who just completed their first semesters.** Ritika Patel and Paighthen Smith were awarded the SOAR Scholarship, a scholarship made possible by donors honoring Lori Schultz when she retired last year as Youth and Family Volunteer Specialist. Lori's love of butterflies inspired the scholarship's name.

**Ritika Patel** is studying Biology at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in New York under the accelerated program in which she will continue her studies to become a doctor at Albany Medical College. Despite the challenges of COVID-19, Ritika has been able to attend her biology and chemistry labs in person. She is finding the freedom of college invigorating, and is already looking forward to the next few years.

"The SOAR Scholarship is helping me accomplish my dreams," Ritika said. The generous award is helping her meet the expenses of her education, relieving some of the stress of affording college.

**Paighthen Smith** is a German language studies major at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, working to fulfill her prerequisite courses for medical school. Paighthen would like to become a pediatrician or geriatrician.

Paighthen is a proud Badger, managing her studies virtually from home. She is serving as the social director for the First Generation Student Success organization. Their goal is to make meaningful connections, address issues of concern and have fun. Despite a first semester made challenging by COVID-19, Paighthen is keeping her positive attitude while looking forward to the future.

Paighthen credits the SOAR Scholarship with allowing her time to help another student. "The Soar Scholarship has made it possible for me to offer volunteer hours to a student with a disability. Without these funds I would have had to take a job to help cover college expenses and would have missed out on this wondrous experience," she said.

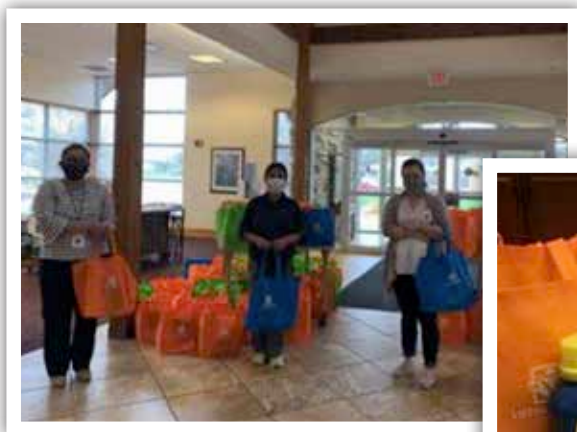

# LOVE BRINGS US TOGETHER

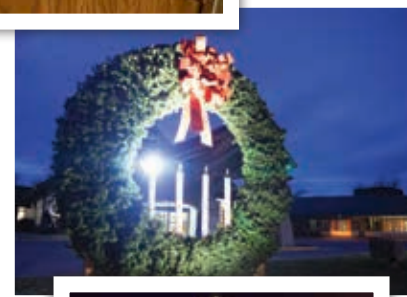
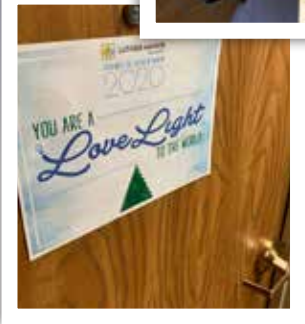

# VOLUNTEER SERVICES IN A COVID-19 WORLD

**2020 started off as a year of great promise but as the year was progressing so was the information about a health crisis starting on the other side of the world.** On Friday, March 13 Volunteers were opening the Little Shoppe, preparing the Health Care Center Coffee Cart and transporting residents to Therapy appointments. Special Event volunteers were partnering with Life Enrichment for a Lumberjack theme lunch for the residents. That day Luther Manor received information from the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and Department of Health Services (DHS) to only allow essential staff in the community going forward as an

We had to envision ways that Volunteer Services could continue to support the Luther Manor community during a global pandemic. Luther Manor Volunteers have creatively answered that call by praying for the Luther Manor community, sewing face masks and reading the quarterly News & Notes and weekly COVID updates posted on the Luther Manor website. Volunteers are keeping connected with phone calls, emails and even FaceTime

in the Manor Mart so their neighbors can safely get their groceries without having to go out in the community. The resident volunteers continue to provide Terrace reception office support, in-house mail delivery, posting notices on bulletin boards, collating quarterly News & Notes, engraving name plates, keeping libraries organized, assisting with the Terrace Resident Den of Antiquity shopping days, leadership with small group activities and a live Veteran's Day





program televised on in-house Channel 956 for the Luther Manor community.

Luther Manor continues to receive generous in-kind gifts for the residents from the volunteers of store-bought cookies, seasonal room decorations, bingo prizes and a special snack delivery for staff. Volunteer Tom Marsden, who volunteered with his wife Brittany in the Ice Cream Parlor, arranged for an amazing donation of over 900 face shields through his company for Luther Manor staff to help protect the residents and rehabilitation guests that we serve.

Volunteers have recently participated virtually in the Friends of Luther Manor sponsored Love Lights event. Their light continues to shine brightly in so many ways even in the middle of a global pandemic. We dearly miss all the community volunteer's presence at Luther Manor but we can still feel the love in their hearts for the Luther Manor community. We will rejoice the day we can welcome community volunteers into our home once again.

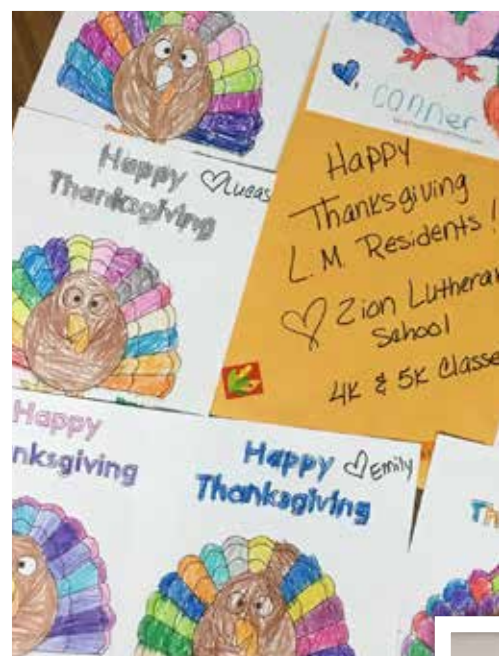
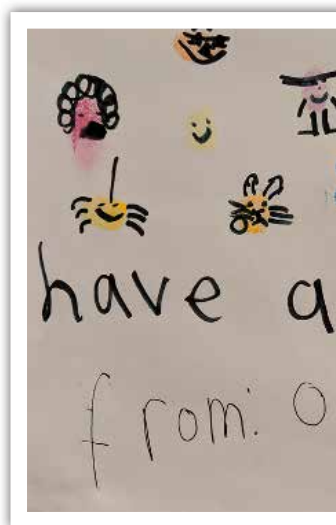

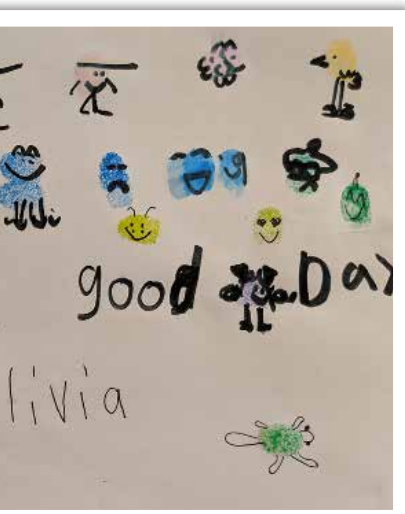
## GOD'S LOVE SHARED WITH RESIDENTS & STAFF

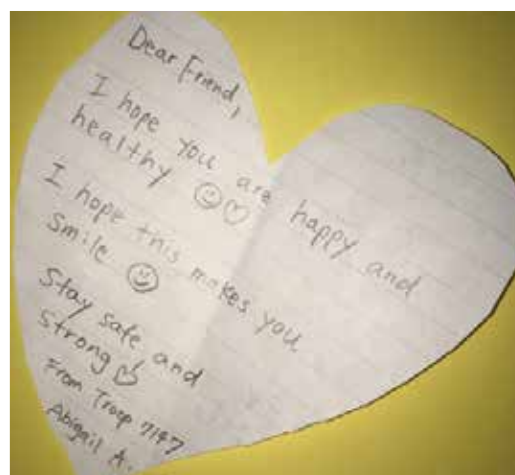
