Campus Update

- We are excited to share our revised visitor guidelines for our Terrace Independent residents as part of our Phase III reopening plan beginning on Monday, March 29.
 - Monday through Friday, from 9:30 am to 3:30 pm only
 - Total of two people may visit per day, per apartment.
 - Additional visitors to the same apartment later on the same day, are not allowed. Please coordinate your visit with friends, family and the resident in advance.
 - No surprise visits. Your loved one must be present to buzz you into the building.
 - There is no longer a minimum age requirement.
 - All visitors are required to screen in at the Terrace STU entrance on the North end of campus or at the Health Care Center entrance. After screening in at either of these locations you may drive to the Terrace CD entrance on the South end of campus if that is closer to your loved one's apartment. A Visitor badge must be worn at all times.
 - All COVID infection prevention steps remain in place:
 - Masks must be worn in the building
 - 6 feet social distance
 - Please use hand sanitizer upon arrival and when leaving
 - Do not visit if you are feeling ill in any way or if you have been exposed to COVID, are being tested for COVID or have been diagnosed with COVID within the last 14 days.
 - Visitors are to go directly to the resident apartment, no visiting with others in public areas. No stopping in the dining venues, libraries, computer rooms or restrooms.
 - Pet visits are not allowed.
 - Visitors must exit the building no later than 3:30 pm. This allows for the disinfection of the entrances, common areas, hallways and elevators. Our enhanced cleaning processes need to start at that time because it takes quite a while to cover all relevant areas due to Luther Manor's size. In addition, this allows other residents to have confidence that they can safely leave their apartment for dinner without encountering people they don't know.
 - Please stay 6 feet apart from staff and other visitors as you screen in.
 - First time visitors, please allow extra time to enter your information into our Accushield visitor screening database. See attached instructions, which are also available at the screening stations.
 - Violating these guidelines puts others at risk and could result in you not being allowed to visit in the future.

- We will send details of enhanced visitation for the Health Care Center and Assisted Living early next week in anticipation of implementing changes the first week of April.
