


Luther Manor Continuing Precautions Related to COVID-19 March 26, 2021 4:52 pm

Campus Update

• We are excited to announce the re-opening of our Courtyard dining room to about 30% capacity of our dining room, effective Monday, March 29th. We leveraged the lessons learned from when we reopened our Independent Living Park Terrace dining room and adjusted protocols for Assisted Living. We will rotate residents that dine in, based on where their apartment is located and the day of week, so all get a chance to socialize while breaking bread with their friends and neighbors. For residents who will not be in the dining room, we will deliver meals to them and 30 minutes later from when we serve in the dining room. Because we have to limit the number of people dining together it will take us two weeks to allow all residents to rotate through. Residents will enter the dining room through one door and exit from another, and will be spaced 6-8 feet apart. Hand sanitizer stations have been added for residents to use as they arrive and depart. The dining music is ready and our wonderful Dining Service and Resident Care Associates are ready to help guide and assist residents for a pleasant experience. We hope this added social interaction is as successful as it has been in the Terrace. We expect to tweak things as we go and will assess next steps toward increasing capacity in the dining room after a successful few weeks.
