


Luther Manor Continuing Precautions Related to COVID-19 March 29, 2021 4:47 pm

Campus Update

- We are excited and so happy to share our revised visitor guidelines for our Health Care Center and Courtyard/River Oaks Assisted Living residents, as part of our Phase III reopening plan. These guidelines begin on Monday, April 5th.
 - Visits will happen Monday through Friday, from 8:15 am to 4:30 pm only
 - o Total of two people may visit per day, per apartment by appointment only.
 - For visits with Health Care Center residents, please schedule your visit with Kathy Jastromski at 414-847-5080 or via email at kjastromski@luthermanor.org.



- Visits with Courtyard residents, please schedule your visit with Shari Garza at 414-847-5079 or via email at sgarza@luthermanor.org.
- Please consider inventorying your loved one's clothing and decorations while you visit.
- Additional visitors to the same apartment later on the same day, are not allowed. Please coordinate your visit with friends, family and the resident in advance so there is no confusion as to who is coming.
- o There is no longer a minimum age requirement.
- All visitors are required to screen in at the Health Care Center entrance only. You must screen out at this desk as well. All COVID infection prevention steps remain in place:
 - Masks must be worn in the building
 - 6 feet social distance
 - Please use hand sanitizer upon arrival and when leaving
 - Do not visit if you are feeling ill in any way or if you have been exposed to COVID, are being tested for COVID or have been diagnosed with COVID within the last 14 days.
- Visitors are to go directly to the resident apartment, no visiting with others in public areas. No stopping in the dining venues, family rooms or restrooms. A map will be provided to help you get to the apartment in the easiest fashion.
- Pet visits are not allowed.
- Visitors must exit the building no later than 4:30 pm. This allows for the disinfection of the entrances, common areas, hallways and elevators. Our enhanced cleaning processes need to start at that time because it takes quite a while to cover all relevant areas due to Luther Manor's size. In addition, this allows other residents to have confidence that they can safely leave their apartment for dinner without encountering people they don't know.
- Please stay 6 feet apart from staff and other visitors as you screen in.
- First time visitors, please allow extra time to enter your information into our Accushield visitor screening database. See attached instructions, which are also available at the screening stations.
- Violating these guidelines puts others at risk and could result in you not being allowed to visit in the future.
