## **Campus Update**

- With our second week of in-person, in-apartment visits underway, we thought it
  would be helpful to remind everyone of the latest visitor guidelines for our Health
  Care Center, Courtyards and River Oaks Assisted Living programs. These
  expanded, responsible indoor visitation guidelines began on Monday, April 5th.
  - One hour visits may be scheduled Monday through Friday, from 8:15 am to 4:30 pm for the time being.
  - A total of two people may visit per day, per apartment, by appointment only.
  - Additional visitors to the same apartment later on the same day, are not allowed. Please coordinate your visit with friends, family and the resident in advance so there is no confusion as to who is coming and when.
  - o There is no longer a minimum age requirement for who can visit.
  - Appointments are limited to help us manage the total number of people in our building at one time.

  - All visitors to our Wauwatosa campus are required to screen in at the Health Care Center or the main Courtyards entrance on 92nd Street. The Courtyards entrance is open during visiting hours only offering more direct access to this program area.
  - All COVID infection prevention requirement remain in place:



- Appropriate masks must be worn <u>at all times in the building,</u> <u>even in resident rooms.</u>
- Keep 6 feet social distance in hallways and in resident rooms when possible.
- Please use hand sanitizer upon arrival and when leaving.
- Do not visit if you are feeling ill in any way or if you have been exposed to COVID, are being tested for COVID or have been diagnosed with COVID within the last 14 days.
- Please do not eat food with the person you are visiting.
- Visitors are to go directly to the resident rooms. No visiting with others in public areas. No stopping in the dining venues or family rooms.
- Please consider inventorying your loved one's clothing and decorations while you visit to determine whether your loved one is in need of new items since you last visited.
- If you are new to Luther Manor, a map will be provided to help you find your way following the most efficient route. Additional signage is being installed to help you navigate our campus.
- Pet visits are not allowed at this time.
- Visitors must exit the building no later than 4:30 pm. This allows time for the disinfecting of our entrances, common areas, hallways and elevators. Our enhanced cleaning processes need to start at this time because it takes quite a while to cover all relevant areas due to Luther Manor's size. In addition, this allows other residents to have confidence that they can safely leave their room without encountering people they don't know.
- o Please stay 6 feet apart from staff and other visitors as you screen in.
- First time visitors, please allow extra time to enter your information into our Accushield visitor screening database.
- Violating these guidelines puts others at risk and could result in you not being allowed to visit in the future.

Please understand that this is a starting point for our reopening. As we are able to ease additional restrictions, we will do so and communicate accordingly. Along the same line, we are evolving our practices again, so please bear with us if we tweak how we are doing things. We so appreciate your understanding, support, partnership and patience over this past year plus!
