Campus Update

- We are finalizing the enhancements to the next steps of our reopening plan, that include:
 - Increasing the number of residents that can attend small group activities and/or faith services from 15 to 20 total attendees. This increase is only going to be in those rooms that have space for 6 feet social distancing.
 - We are also looking at restarting our Terrace Singer's Choir in early June.
