

Luther Manor Continuing Precautions Related to COVID-19

The safety of our residents and staff remains our top priority and we will continue with our protocols, precautions and screening of all staff, visitors upon arrival and all Health Care Center and Assisted Living Residents.

Campus Update

- We have received the final test results for all of the Courtyards residents and staff from this week's retesting and all are negative! With this said, the quarantine is discontinued and visits can resume effective immediately. Thank you for your patience as we worked through the quarantine to stem the spread. And thank you to all the staff for their diligence in performing disinfecting, following the correct PPE protocols and applying appropriate precautions.
- The Courtyards program can resume visits effective immediately with the same precautions/restrictions we shared earlier this week to help us keep everyone as safe as possible. Please review the ongoing rules and let us know if you have any questions.
 - No appointments are required for visits.
 - Visits are allowed seven days a week in all areas
 - There are no restrictions to visiting hours
 - o There is a limit of 2 people visiting at the same time. We are limiting the number of visitors due to the size of some of the rooms and to avoid larger gatherings.
 - However, there is no limit to the number of times a resident can have visitors on any given day.
 - You must screen in and out at an approved entrance:
 - Terrace STU entrance: Mon. Fri. 9:30 am 4:00 pm
 - Courtyards entrance: Mon. Fri. from 8:00 am 4:00 pm
 - The Health Care Center: is 24 hours a day, seven days a week and is the after-hours and weekend approved entrance. If you are visiting the Terrace or Courtyards after the above times, please screen in at the Health Care Center before proceeding to your program area and use this entrance to screen out.
 - o There is no time limit for visits.
 - Masks must be worn at all times regardless of vaccination status or if you've had COVID. Health care environments, like Luther Manor, are



- excluded from the new CDC guidance removing mask mandates for vaccinated people.
- Please do not visit if you are not feeling well.
- Take the most direct route to your loved one's room or apartment and do not visit with other residents along the way.
- You may visit in the resident's apartment or outside, we ask that you not visit in indoor public spaces or hallways.
- With this change, families/friends are once again encouraged to take packages, etc. directly to the resident's room or apartment AFTER successfully screening in and being symptom free.
- If you take your loved one out for the day, please inform a staff member.
 You are able to pick them up in their room/apartment AFTER successfully screening in and being symptom free, as well as return them to their room/apartments.
- We are also reinstating pet visits. In addition to the above requirements:
 - The pets must be current on all of their shots.
 - Visits must occur in resident rooms, not hallways or common areas.
 - Residents must wash and/or sanitize hands before and immediately following the pet visit.
 - We ask that the pets not visit with other residents or staff. We know this will be hard!
