Campus Update

- We continue to watch updates from the Department of Health and CDC and are just now starting to see some lessening of restrictions for those individuals that are vaccinated. More information to come I am sure, yet here is a start of some pending changes:
 - Staff members that are fully vaccinated will no longer be required to be routinely tested for COVID-19. All other staff members will be tested per the County frequency rate, which currently requires weekly testing.
 - We are finalizing details on our partnership for ongoing COVID-19 vaccinations for new residents and staff to receive the Moderna vaccine. More details will be forthcoming.
 - We are increasing our Courtyard dining room resident count to 50% of our residents. We will continue to maintain proper social distancing and hand hygiene, yet this will allow for our residents to have more interactions with their friends and neighbors.
- We have adjusted our resident visiting times for our Courtyards and River
 Oaks Assisted Living programs. Visits are now from 9 am-4 pm, which allows
