Campus Update

• We are excited to announce that we are starting a new COVID-19 vaccination program partnership in a couple of weeks. The program will be administering the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine first and second doses through our partnership with Health Direct. These will be administered at no charge to the resident or staff member receiving them. We will coordinate the second vaccination no sooner than the proper 28 day time parameter. All new resident vaccinations will be signed off by the resident unless their power of attorney has been activated and all employees will get their vaccine forms from Human Resources. If you are helping your loved one or you are the medical power of attorney, please complete the attached form and return to our Infection Control Nurse Karen Yust via email at at kyust@luthermanor.org. I have also included an educational piece on the Moderna vaccine that will help you make an informed decision.

Through our partnership, we will schedule ongoing vaccinations as long as we have a required 2nd vaccination occurring or once we have a combined total of 10 residents and/or staff members. Please let me know if you have any questions and thank you for doing your share to help keep everyone as safe as we can while a threat of COVID-19 still exists.

 Reminder for anyone taking a loved one out for Mother's Day, we have changed our process so that you can now escort your loved one back to his or her apartment to say goodbye. Anyone visiting or taking a resident out on any day
