Campus Updates

- As positive cases of the Delta Variant continue to grow, we realize the facts are
 that this variant is impacting those that are not vaccinated. Now that we are over
 six months from when we held our first vaccination clinic, we ask that if you
 chose to not have your loved one vaccinated, that you re-evaluate the results of
 those vaccinated thus far. Of course, we are having the same dialog with our
 staff members!
 - We have seen overwhelming evidence that the vaccination was done safely and has not had the negative effects the rumor mill and social media has claimed. Conversely, if a vaccinated person does become infected with the Delta variant the vaccine is helping reduce the symptoms. If interested in having your loved one vaccinated, simply reach out to your loved ones' social worker to let them know you would like for them to be vaccinated. You can certainly reach out to me as well. Thank you for re-considering this!
- With continued precaution we are making some enhancements to our COVID-19 protocols regarding activities, worship and resident engagement. The following changes go into effect as noted next to each.

TOTAL CAMPUS - All effective immediately

- o Masks still required for all staff and visitors, no change in this guideline
- Any signs or symptoms of illness staff and visitors still need to stay away
- Residents from different program areas can commingle with each other for activities and only need to sign in as attending for contact tracing needs.

TERRACE - All effective immediately

- Dining room mask and spacing is all voluntary
- o 3-foot distance in elevators, vs. 6
- Bus capacity now has no resident limit, yet masks required
- o Our Fitness rooms now have no limit, residents are required to sign in.



COURTYARD

- Ice Cream Parlor will reopen once we have volunteers ready to serve.
 We will start with pre-packaged ice cream goods such as ice cream sandwiches, drumsticks, fudgesicles, etc. for now. We will let you know the date once we have it ready.
- Family rooms are now ok to use with visitors. They must be reserved in advance through the Courtyard reception desk 414-847-5073. Rooms will be cleaned and disinfected after each use. Capacity is still limited to 2 visitors.

What better way to help our Courtyard residents have a little fun making something and then to keep their minds sharp by playing a classic!
