Today's update is off our typical Wednesday update schedule because we want to alert you that a temporary staff member working in the health care center tested positive for COVID. All residents and staff who may have been in contact with this person have been contacted as have family members. If you haven't heard from us, your loved one is not affected. Read more below.

Campus Updates

- As referenced above one staff member tested positive for COVID-19 in the health care center. This staff member worked one day (August 11th) and we have completed contact tracing. All residents in the unit were tested today. Staff testing began today as well. We will continue with testing this group every 5 - 7 days until we have two consecutive negative results. Unfortunately, this means there are no visitors on this unit until further notice. We will keep everyone updated with our regular Wednesday update, unless another urgent update is necessary.
- Our vaccination clinic this week helped vaccinate five previously unvaccinated staff members and one resident. The vaccinations are being administered through our partnership with the Wauwatosa Department of Health. Their team has committed to continue helping us in all the ways they can. To protect yourself and one another, we encourage all staff and everyone who is medically able, to get vaccinated. If you or a loved one has chosen not to in the past, we encourage you to reconsider. You and your personal doctor are the best team in making this decision.
- The Milwaukee County COVID positivity rate has climbed above 10% this week, which means our staff testing protocols the week of August 16 will be bi-weekly for all non-vaccinated staff members.
