### Campus Updates

- Good news! Our final round of staff and resident testing in our rehab units came back negative. We will once again be able to admit new patients and will be out of quarantine precautions on August 28. This also means that visits can resume with residents on this unit beginning August 28.
- As a reminder, ALL visitors and staff who are in resident care areas must wear BOTH a face mask and a face shield at all times regardless of vaccination status. Please wear a face mask upon entering the building and after screening in at our Kiosk, take a new surgical mask and a face shield located at the entrance of the unit to wear during your visit. When you leave, please throw both the face shield and mask away in the appropriate waste bin and wear your own face mask to screen out before exiting the building. Thanks for helping ensure our residents' safety.
- Next Thursday from 1-3 pm, the Wauwatosa Health Department will be back at Luther Manor to provide the COVID vaccine to residents, staff, family or friends for FREE. Please spread the word and contact [Karen Yust](#) to sign up so we can let the Health Department know how much vaccine to have on hand. Please contact your loved one's social worker if you would like for your loved one to get vaccinated.

- Based on the positivity rate in Milwaukee County, we continue to test all non-vaccinated staff on our Wauwatosa Campus twice a week.
