Campus Updates

- A staff member in the Rehabilitation program tested positive for COVID. As a result, the Rehabilitation Units 1700, 1800 and 1900 are in quarantine effective immediately. Unfortunately, this means that in-person visits with the Rehab residents are postponed until we come out of guarantine. All residents and staff in the program are being tested - regardless of vaccination status. If all of these tests are negative, a second round of testing will take place in approximately 5-7 days. If all are negative after the second round of tests the program area can reopen. We will keep you updated as the days pass and tests are returned. We have conducted contact tracing and communicated with anyone who may have come in direct contact with this staff member. All families having loved ones affected have been contacted. Our heightened precautions, screenings and ongoing monitoring help to mitigate the spread if and when someone does become ill or tests positive.
- Our top priority continues to be stopping this virus and doing our best to keep COVID-19 from spreading. We will continue to do our best to connect personally with each resident on a regular basis and strive to engage with them and help them through these difficult times, regardless of what phase of quarantine or reopening we are in. We will keep everyone updated as we have more information.
