## **Campus Updat es**

- Following up on our ongoing testing and re-testing of residents and staff, there
  are no new cases in the Courtyards or the Health Care Center. The second
  round of resident and staff testing is complete and all test results came back
  negative.
- We are excited to announce we have hired Tina Bell to be our new Beautician for the Health Services areas. Tina has been a beautician/stylist/barber for over 40 years at private salons and serving seniors at another senior living community. Tina considers herself respectful, caring, pleasing to her customers and loves working with seniors. She lives on the southside of Milwaukee, has been married over 20 years and has seven children.

- We are also excited to announce that we have scheduled our Moderna booster vaccination clinic for Saturday, November 13th for all residents and staff. More details will follow including if any forms will be required. What we do know is that they will be able to administer the 1st, 2nd or booster vaccine. For the 2nd vaccination and the booster the only paperwork that should be necessary is the original vaccination card. The clinic will run from 8:00 am 5:00 pm in our Faith and Education Center and the Linden Room of our Terrace Independent Living area. We are inquiring if the Pfizer booster will be able to be administered and will update this as we get closer.
- Today we learned that a staff member at our River Oaks assisted living facility in Mequon tested positive for COVID. On Monday, we implemented precautions when this staff member began displaying symptoms. Residents who had direct exposure to this staff member were tested and all are negative. One of these residents will remain in quarantine out of an abundance of caution. Residents will be retested on Monday, Oct 25. Staff will continue to monitor themselves and all residents for COVID symptoms. Visitations can continue at the location following proper precautions.



- Visit protocols continue with the following requirements in place to keep residents and staff safe:
  - We will communicate when we have a case in a particular area
  - All visitors are required to use hand sanitizer when entering the area and we encourage you to use it throughout your visit
  - Please try not to touch high-contact areas in resident rooms such as bed trays
  - You must wear a face mask for your entire visit, even when you are alone with the resident
  - Visit only in the resident rooms or apartments, no common area visits are allowed
  - If you are not feeling well in any way, please refrain from visiting until you are better
