## **Campus Updates**

- Following up on our ongoing testing and re-testing of River Oaks residents and staff, there are no new cases anywhere on the Wauwatosa campus or River Oaks - knock on wood!. We still have the one resident who will remain in quarantine until October 31st to help everyone in the program safe.

 We implemented one of our proactive security objectives earlier today by completing a routine exterior door lock change throughout the campus. The keys have a larger square head, which will allow for easier identification and also allow for an easier grip on the key when using.

• Reminder, our COVID Vaccine Clinic is set for Saturday, November 13th for all residents and staff. This clinic will include options to receive the 1st, 2nd or booster dose of either the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine. The clinic will run from 8:00 am - 5:00 pm in our Faith and Education Center for staff and all Health Care Center and Courtyards residents. We've again arranged to make this easy for our Terrace residents by offering a second location in the Linden Room. Staff will work with all residents to register them for an appointment and to complete the necessary paperwork. Terrace residents will need to present their



vaccination card and insurance information to schedule an appointment and at the time of the vaccination.
