## **Campus Updates**

- A fully vaccinated and boosted support staff member tested positive for COVID-19. They had direct contact with two other staff members only and those who may have been exposed to this staff member have been communicated with and are being tested per required timing standards. There were no residents who had direct contact with this staff member.
- I thought it would be helpful to reiterate the newest CDC visitor guidelines that we have implemented at Luther Manor.
  - There is no longer a limit in any of our program areas to the number or age of the people who can visit at the same time.
  - Visits can occur even if there is a positive case as long as we can ensure potential exposure is mitigated.
  - If you are not feeling well and/or answer yes to any of our screening questions upon arrival, please do not visit. Even cold or allergy symptoms can be a sign of COVID-19. Please do not risk your loved one's health. We'd be happy to assist with a virtual visit as a safer way to remain connected with your loved one.
  - All visitors are required to screen-in at designated entrances and wear face masks during the entirety of the visit.
  - It is imperative that all visitors practice proper hand hygiene upon arrival, frequently during the visit and upon departure. Hand sanitizer is readily available throughout Luther Manor.
  - If you have any symptoms or are simply not feeling well, do not visit until you speak with one of our staff members about your specific circumstances.
