

EXCITING UPDATES TO CARE AREAS, PROGRAMS 6

We are very grateful to begin our 62nd year in senior living this June, but we are equally excited to announce some brand new renovations and programming coming to Luther Manor in 2023!

This Spring, The Gardens at Luther Manor, our new memory care program, will be opening! The Gardens will offer multidisciplinary services designed to meet unique needs and enhance the quality of life for those with various forms of dementia. The program's benefits will include increased social participation, physical and emotional health monitoring, and activities for daily living assistance. Our goal is to maximize the resident's independence, using an individualized approach that includes small groups, frequent one-to-one interactions, and activities geared to the resident's needs..

Also coming this year are brand new entrances off of 92nd Street, into The Courtyards (assisted living), and into The Terrace (independent living). We are also putting in a new therapy gym, a cafe and lounge in The Courtyards, and new dining rooms for our long-term care and rehab residents. Lots to look forward to!



LUTHER MANOR AWARDED BEST NURSING HOME & CCRC



COMMUNITY WIDE & PROGRAM RECOGNITION

Luther Manor was recognized by U.S. News & World Report as one of the best Continuing Care Retirement Communites (CCRC) in the U.S. and one of the best short-term rehabilitation and long-term care programs. Exceeding national averages in several key areas, Luther Manor was recognized for our ability to help return patients home, to reduce falls and infections which lead to rehospitalizations, as well as a low number of emergency room visits. We were also recognized for a high level of flu and COVID-19 vaccinations for residents and staff.

A BLESSED HISTORY FINDS A NEW HOME

In 1977, thirteen Deaconesses (or Lutheran Sisters), who had served in Milwaukee hospitals, made Luther Manor their home and brought with them sacred worship items, Bibles, communion ware, vases, photographs and more! These gifts have been used throughout generations and, last April, were moved and rededicated to our newly renovated lobby of our Faith & Edeucation Center where they are more prominently displayed. Leadership, staff, and residents alike joined in the ceremony, processional and rededication.

ENRICHING THE LIVES OF OUR OLDER ADULTS

DID YOU KNOW THAT:

- 1 in 3 adults 65+ fall 200% below the federal poverty level?
- 6 in 10 of them will need long-term care at some point?
- Public assistance only covers 45-65% of the cost of their care, leaving a significant gap?

These same adults often end up in substandard living situations with little to no care. Their health deteriorates more quickly, leaving them abandoned, alone & destitute at the end of their life.

In 60+ years, no resident has been asked to leave Luther Manor solely due to their inability to pay because:

The Luther Manor Foundation bridges the gap between public assistance & the actual cost of care, providing \$5 million dollars in unreimbursed charity care in 2021. Without donors to the Luther Manor Foundation, the support needed to provide compassionate care isn't available.
